

Questions for further study .... June 27<sup>th</sup>  
"Lost" - part 2

(if you missed last week's study ... see the notes from June 20<sup>th</sup> ... also based on this passage.)

Read Luke 15:11-32.

1. Read Luke 18:9-14. Contrast the attitude of the two men in this story. How does this help us understand what Jesus criticized about the Pharisees? See also Luke 15:1,2. What do you think Jesus wanted these Pharisees to draw from the story of the lost son? How can "religiosity" become a barrier to us truly understanding about relationship with God?

2. Heaven is the Christian's final home, where we will live forever with Jesus and all his people.

It's God's presence in this eternal home that will transform everything.

Read Jesus' promise in John 14:1-4. It will be a place of peace, joy, beauty, and justice. Look up 1 Corinthians 15:35-54. What can you learn from this passage about our future hope?
