Key Facts About Eternity

(1) Everyone will exist eternally either in heaven or hell
Daniel 12:2,3; Matthew 25:46; John 5:28,29;

Revelation 20:14,15

(2) Everyone has only one life in which to determine their destiny

Hebrews 9:27,28

(3) Heaven or hell is determined by whether a person believes (puts their trust) in Christ alone to save them
John 3:16, 36.
