Godly Perspective

1. Give examples of times when you or someone you know has made a wrong decision or come to a faulty conclusion because you didn't see a situation or problem clearly. Why do we jump to conclusions, instead of waiting before we leap?
2. How would you describe "putting something into perspective" to someone? Why is this important? What happens if we "lose" our perspective?
3. (v13) What does it mean when Peter urges us to be *alert and fully sober*? We are also called to be holy. What does that look like in practical terms?
4. (v17) Why is it so hard to live as an alien or foreigner? In what ways are we called to be distinctive? Would a complete stranger be able to tell that you differ from everyone else by watching you day by day? What practical steps can you take to align your lifestyle with God's word? (See also Romans 12:2)
5. (v9) What do these titles mean for us? Do you feel like God's special possession? If no, what is stopping you from believing this? (You may like to pause at this point and pray over people.)
6. What do you know about our promised eternal life with God? What will it be like? Share some scriptures together to encourage and uphold each other.
7. How can you maintain an eternal perspective? Pray for each other that you may be a distinctive light to those who walk in darkness this week.
