- 5. Read Luke 12:15. How would you define greed? Four types of greed associated with money are hoarding, overspending, comparison, and entitlement. What do each of these look like?
- 6. Why is it hard to identify greed in ourselves? What habits should we cultivate to combat greed in our lives?
