- 2. How does a spiritual gift differ from a natural talent? Are spiritual gifts permanent or just for a season?
- 3. Do you know what your spiritual gift is? How are you using your gift?
- 4. As a group, find out what gifts are represented among you. In what ways might you collectively use your gifts to build up the church, serve others, and/or point to Jesus?
- 5. Matt used a quote by Jonathan Goforth. "After all, what is revival but simply the Spirit of God fully controlling in the surrendered life? It must always be possible then, when man yields."
