Questions for further study



The Road to Redemption 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2025 Matt 26:17-30

- 1. Do you have any special ways or occasions to remember things in your family, apart from birthdays and major feasts? How did these traditions begin?
- 2. Read Ex 6:6-8. Why was it important for the Jews to remember this moment in history? Have you ever shared a Passover meal? If so, what struck you most about the evening? (You might want to think about sharing one as a homegroup.)
- 3. What are the ways that Jesus fulfilled God's four promises to the Israelites in Exodus? (Free, redeem, take, and bring).
- 4. Use today's passage in Matthew as a meditation. Have everyone close their eyes and imagine they are there with Jesus. Read the passage slowly once. Allow time for people to think and then read it again slowly. (Perhaps you might like to read from two different versions.) Afterwards have people talk about what impacted them most, what they noticed that they hadn't considered before, and what God was saying to them.
- 5. Perhaps you could have a time of worship to rejoice in your salvation, and/or share communion together. Some song suggestions are <u>here</u>.
