



## DOOR HANGER

1. Cut shapes out of the hessian & the lining. Pin the ribbon on the right side of the hessian where it's marked on the template, then pin the lining on top.
2. Stitch round the edge of the shape (running stitch is easiest, with a second row to fill the gaps) but leaving about 4" so that you can then turn it inside out. Make the edge nice & flat – use an iron if you prefer.
3. Curl into a cone and pin, then stitch.
4. Sew the crochet flower or a button in place.
