



## **"Spirit-led evangelism"**

- Study questions

Continuing our theme for the year about "keeping in step with the Spirit" we're taking 5 Sunday mornings to explore how the Holy Spirit wants to lead & empower our life together as a church & our shared mission. We'll be basing this in letters written by leaders of the early church, and looking at how we can relate these principles into our culture.

1. Why should we witness to people?

How would you answer someone who said that evangelism was unloving?

2. Read Ephesians 1:3-14.

v13 talks about "the message of truth". What does this passage say that message is?

How would you summarize the good news that we have to share?

What is the Holy Spirit's role in evangelism? What is ours?

How can we be to the praise of His glory? v14

3. Take 2 minutes each to share how you came to faith in Jesus, and the difference that knowing Him has made in your lives.

4. Read Jesus' promise in Luke 12:11-12. Give examples of times when you have proved this to be true.

5. We talked about different aspects of evangelism – words, deeds & signs. Give biblical & contemporary examples of these. Discuss the interplay between these things – and why they are all necessary.

Pray for the Holy Spirit's empowering that we would "go & share" as well as invite others to "come & see."
