Spirit-Led Service

1. Think of people in your life who you have admired and tried to imitate. Were they a good influence or bad? We are called to imitate Christ. (Rom 8 v29) What qualities do you see in him that would you like to cultivate in your own life?
2. Read 1 Peter 4 v10. Do you know what your spiritual gifts are? Are you currently using them to serve God? If not, what is stopping you? (If anyone is unsure about their gifts, encourage them to speak to Matt or Gordon about discovering them)
3. 1 Cor 12 v27 says that we are a “necessary part” of the fellowship. Do you feel as if you are part of the body of Christ? What could TBC do to encourage people to be part of the bigger fellowship?
4. Sometimes we can get distracted with trivial things instead of using our time wisely. What would you say is your biggest time waster? Discuss how you can achieve a balance between work, rest, family and other commitments while maintaining a vibrant relationship with God.
5. What are you passionate about? God often uses the things that bring us joy when he calls us to serve. Will this remain the same throughout your walk with Christ?
6. 2 Tim 1 v6 entreats us to “fan into flame the gift of God.” Do you feel as if you have “cooled” in your Christian faith? How can you relight the embers and stir up the passion you once had? What legacy are you leaving for the next generation?
7. Spend time in prayer asking the Holy Spirit to excite and direct you in your service.
