## 1. Our resources

Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> '19

1. Read Psalm 24. How does this Psalm show us God as the King of Glory? How should this influence the way we worship Him? What is your response to v1 "The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it"?

2. Read 1 Chronicles 29:1-14.

i) What does this passage show us about David's perspective on giving? What effect did his giving have on others? What motivates you to give generously?

ii) What does David's prayer in v10-13 reveal about his view of God?

How is our view of God related to our willingness (or unwillingness) to give generously? In what other ways can we express our devotion to the Lord?

3. Read Mark 10:17-22 & Mark 12:41-44. What can we learn from these two passages about Jesus' relationship to us, and our relationship to money?

If God owns everything and I am simply His steward, then what does He want me to do with His stuff?

4. Over these 3 weeks we're looking at giving in terms of our resources, our responsibilities & our relationships. Think practically of what it might mean to you to say "Jesus is Lord of my resources"?
