

## King of my Heart - Obedience

Questions for Further Study

October 20<sup>th</sup> 2019

1. What do you think of when you hear the word "obedience"? How does our culture view the idea of obedience?
2. Read Ezekiel 2: 1-7. This passage comes just after Ezekiel has an astounding vision of God and has fallen face down on the ground in worship. Have you ever had a vision of God, or lost yourself in worship? How did it change/challenge you?
3. God sends Ezekiel out into a hostile environment to speak to rebellious people. In what way is our culture similar? How can Ezekiel's example help us?
4. Ezekiel had to choose to obey God, not just once but many times when faced with pressure and difficulties. How hard is it to remain obedient? What has helped you to make the right choices, especially during adversity?
5. Why should we be obedient? (*Talk about the fact that it is a command from Jesus, an act of worship, it is rewarded/blessed by God.*)
6. To be obedient means putting God first. In what ways can we do this? How are we tempted to put ourselves on the throne instead of God?
7. Spend some time in prayer and worship. Commit yourselves to being obedient and wait on God.
