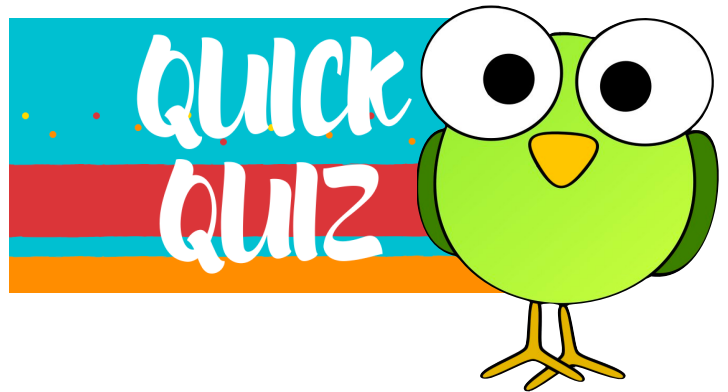

Want to go even Deeper?

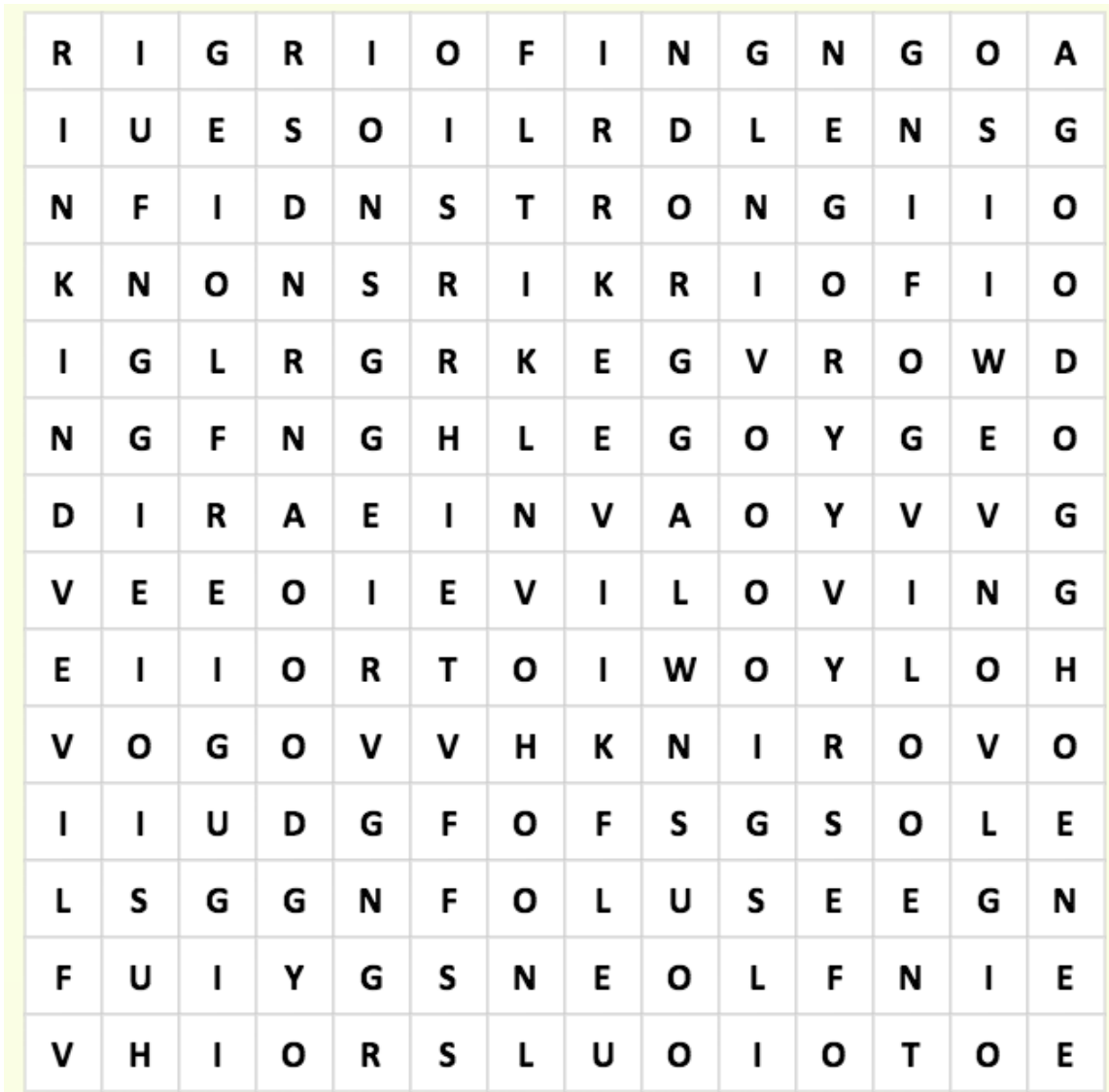


Ok, so what even IS trust?
