

Study questions following on from the Easter Sunday talk



Start by reading the whole of **Luke 24**

- i) The two disciples called Jesus: "a mighty prophet" and "Jesus of Nazareth." They don't refer to Him as the Messiah or King. How do these two descriptions of Jesus in verse 19 give insight into what these two disciples thought of Him?
- ii) Read v21. These two had lost hope. Discuss as a group what it must have been like for them to think that the redeemer of Israel was dead.
- iii) v25-27. Why do you think Jesus takes the time to re-explain the scriptures to these two instead of just revealing who He was?

We talked about truths that this incident illustrates:

- Jesus is present with us
- Jesus always makes sense of things
- Jesus waits for our invitation
- Jesus makes Himself known to us.

What are you learning about each of these in our current situation?

Read **Ephesians 1:15-22** and then pray this prayer for people close to you.
