2. Have you ever had your way blocked? By what - roadworks? Cows? A gate? Crowds? Or maybe something blocked your way to doing something fun, like feeling poorly, or having to tidy your room? What did you do?
3. Why did Joshua ask the Israelites to build a pile of 12 stones?
4. Can you remember any of God's promises to us?
5. Would you rather have a robot helper or a pet monkey? Would you rather be a singer or an actor? Would you rather have breakfast in a hot air balloon or dinner in a castle?
6. Do you have ways of marking or celebrating special memories in your family?
7. Is Sunday a special day in your family? What do you do that is different to the rest of the week?
8. How do you think God stopping the river for them changed the way the Israelites felt about going to capture Jericho?
9. How was your week? What was the most fun thing you did?
10. What was Joshua like as a leader? Would you have followed him? Why? Why not?
11. What do you miss most - sport, shopping or swimming?
12. Who could you send a virtual / postcard hug to this week?
