

Leaders' Notes for Zoom meeting with Children's Groups

He is for us : Joshua and the land God promised Session 3 – He makes a way for us

Zoom Procedure:

- Leaders join Zoom first, and are last out. There must be at least two DBS holding adults leading. If a leader fails to join, as long as the present leader has a DBS, let in a parent and ask them to stay until another leader arrives.
- Children must have a parent with them on screen when they enter the zoom call. This then signifies consent and will be made clear in emails containing the zoom link. The parent need not stay after that.
- The zoom call mustn't be recorded.
- In all other ways comply with the existing church safeguarding policy.

Zoom Plan:

Timing	Activity	Notes
0-10	<p>Welcome: Welcome question on powerpoint: What fun thing have you done this week? KS1 game: Age 3 -4: Noisy Farmyard – Call out animals: pig, dog, duck, cow, sheep, and the children make the noises. Go big – elephant, tiger, monkey. Age 5-7: Higher lower : All stand. Show a playing card. They point up for higher, down for lower. Turn over next card. Those who get it right are still in, those who are wrong sit down. KS2 game: Higher , lower</p>	<p>Unmute all as children arrive – make visual contact with a parent. Then mute all and go round to hear children speak, unmuting one child at a time. Establish signal eg. hands up / hat on / finger on nose to speak during discussion.</p>
10-20	<p>Recap story: Recap story using cartoon or stills on powerpoint, followed by quick quiz on powerpoint: KS1: True / False answers – children show thumbs up or thumbs down. KS2: Children use coloured objects to register answers.</p>	
20-25	<p>Discussion: KS1: Do you remember your last birthday? What did you do? What were your parents remembering? What is your best memory? Why did Joshua put up the pile of stones? What did it help them remember about God? What would you like to remember about God every day? KS2: What is your best memory? What did the Israelites needed to remember about God? Why? What does it help us to remember about God in our everyday lives? How can we make sure we remember?</p>	
25-30	<p>Pray and goodbye: Ask children for prayer requests. Allow individuals to pray – leader to close.</p>
