

Leaders' Notes for Zoom meeting with Children's Groups

Get your Hero on Session 2 – Empowered by God

Zoom Procedure:

- Leaders join Zoom first, and are last out. There must be at least two DBS holding adults leading. If a leader fails to join, as long as the present leader has a DBS, let in a parent and ask them to stay until another leader arrives.
- Children must have a parent with them on screen when they enter the zoom call. This then signifies consent and will be made clear in emails containing the zoom link. The parent need not stay after that.
- The zoom call mustn't be recorded.
- In all other ways comply with the existing church safeguarding policy.

- **Zoom Plan:**

Timing	Activity	Notes
0-5	<p>Welcome: Welcome question on powerpoint: What fun thing have you done this week? Game: KS1: Bigger or smaller. Put some items in a bag. Pick out each item, and children have to guess if it will be bigger or smaller than the last one. KS2: 3 in 10. Give the children categories – they have to type three things in that category in 10 seconds. Categories: 3 superpowers, 3 choc bars, 3 cold months, 3 small animals, 3 things you might wear, 3 rooms in a house, 3 foods at a BBQ, 3 hot drinks.</p>	<p>Unmute all as children arrive – make visual contact with a parent. Then mute all and go round to hear children speak, unmuting one child at a time. Establish signal eg. hands up / hat on / finger on nose to speak during discussion.</p>
5-15	<p>Recap story: Recap story using stills on powerpoint followed by quick quiz on powerpoint: KS1: True / False answers – children show thumbs up or thumbs down. KS2: Children use coloured objects to register answers.</p>	
15-20	<p>Hero Academy Discussion (Captain Awesome's top tips) KS1: How big was Goliath? Do you think David was scared? Do you think God helped him win? KS2: How big was Goliath? How do we know that David trusted God? Look up Psalm 121.</p>	
20-25	<p>Pray: Ask children for prayer requests. Allow individuals to pray – leader to close.</p>	
25-30	<p>News: Ask the children to share their news before saying goodbye.</p>
