

Leaders' Notes for Zoom meeting with Children's Groups

Get your Hero on Session 3 – Led by God

Zoom Procedure:

- Leaders join Zoom first, and are last out. There must be at least two DBS holding adults leading. If a leader fails to join, as long as the present leader has a DBS, let in a parent and ask them to stay until another leader arrives.
- Children must have a parent with them on screen when they enter the zoom call. This then signifies consent and will be made clear in emails containing the zoom link. The parent need not stay after that.
- The zoom call mustn't be recorded.
- In all other ways comply with the existing church safeguarding policy.

- **Zoom Plan:**

Timing	Activity	Notes
0-5	<p>Welcome: Welcome question on powerpoint: What fun thing have you done this week? Game: Have a tray with three identical cups on camera. Place a lego superhero under one of the cups and move all three cups around the tray. Stop, then ask the children to point – left, right or middle, as to where they think the superhero is hiding. To make harder, use three superheroes, and ask them to point to the position of a specific one.</p>	Unmute all as children arrive – make visual contact with a parent. Then mute all and go round to hear children speak, unmuting one child at a time.
5-15	<p>Recap story: Recap story using stills on powerpoint followed by quick quiz on powerpoint: KS1: True / False answers – children show thumbs up or thumbs down. KS2: Children use coloured objects to register answers.</p>	Establish signal eg. hands up / hat on / finger on nose to speak during discussion.
15-20	<p>Hero Academy Discussion (Captain Awesome's top tips) KS1: How was David led by God? How can we be led by God? Talk about the bible and prayer. KS2: How can we be led by God? Look at psalm 119 v 105. What does this mean for us?</p>	
20-25	<p>Pray: Ask children for prayer requests. Allow individuals to pray – leader to close.</p>	
25-30	<p>News: Ask the children to share their news before saying goodbye.</p>
