Read Col 3:1-17

This passage sets out how to have a Godly perspective. in the opening verse in light of the resurrections what are we called to do and how do put that in to practise.

what do you think of v5-6 - notice the strong language, why was paul using such strong language?

Read 12-17 paul talks as chosen people we are to cloth ourselves with these virtues. How do we practically do that?

Jump back to 1 samuel 17 -

David had a Godly perspective because he knew his God v45-46 and had experience of him v34-37 but that knowledge and experience could only take David so far, it limits him- David needed to take a step of faith.

Why does God call us to take a step of faith? v45-46

Does making God known is done by only taking big steps of faith?

So often we measure our obstacles against our own strength, why is that?

Read Phil. 4:13 how does that encourage you today?

Spend some time praying that God will help us have a Godly perspective on things.
