

Leaders' Notes for Zoom meeting with Children's Groups

Get your Hero on Session 4 – Forgiven by God

Zoom Procedure:

- Leaders join Zoom first, and are last out. There must be at least two DBS holding adults leading. If a leader fails to join, as long as the present leader has a DBS, let in a parent and ask them to stay until another leader arrives.
- Children must have a parent with them on screen when they enter the zoom call. This then signifies consent and will be made clear in emails containing the zoom link. The parent need not stay after that.
- The zoom call mustn't be recorded.
- In all other ways comply with the existing church safeguarding policy.

- **Zoom Plan:**

Timing	Activity	Notes
0-5	<p>Welcome: Welcome question on powerpoint: What fun thing have you done this week? Game: Memory game – take photos of hero related objects on a tray. Remove one item each round – children have to guess the missing item. KS1 – 15 items on the tray. The first and last slides have all the items on. KS2 – 20 items. Slide 1 is all objects, next 4 have one item missing, next three have 2 missing, last slide is all items</p>	<p>Unmute all as children arrive – make visual contact with a parent. Then mute all and go round to hear children speak, unmuting one child at a time.</p> <p>Establish signal eg. hands up / hat on / finger on nose to speak during discussion.</p>
5-15	<p>Recap story: Recap story using stills on powerpoint followed by quick quiz on powerpoint: KS1: True / False answers – children show thumbs up or thumbs down. KS2: Children use coloured objects to register answers.</p>	
15-20	<p>Hero Academy Discussion (Captain Awesome's top tips) Discuss the fresh start we get from God time after time. KS1: What do you do when someone says sorry to you? How does God respond when we say sorry to him? KS2: How did David know he had done the wrong thing? How did he respond when he knew God had forgiven him? Does God always forgive us? Even if we keep doing the same thing?</p>	
20-25	<p>Pray: Ask children for prayer requests. Allow individuals to pray – leader to close.</p>	
25-30	<p>News: Ask the children to share their news before saying goodbye.</p>
