

Leaders' Notes for Zoom meeting with Children's Groups

Get your Hero on : Session 5 – Sustained by God

Zoom Procedure:

- Leaders join Zoom first, and are last out. There must be at least two DBS holding adults leading. If a leader fails to join, as long as the present leader has a DBS, let in a parent and ask them to stay until another leader arrives.
- Children must have a parent with them on screen when they enter the zoom call. This then signifies consent and will be made clear in emails containing the zoom link. The parent need not stay after that.
- The zoom call mustn't be recorded.
- In all other ways comply with the existing church safeguarding policy.

Timing	Activity	Notes
0-5	<p>Welcome: Welcome question on powerpoint: What fun thing have you done this week? Game: Spot the difference. Look at the slide, then watch out for changes! KS1 – 1. Purple guy upside down 2. Red caped guy and girl swapped places. 3. Blue caped girl has disappeared. 4. Red caped guy is flying. 5. Bat man is standing still. 6. Purple guy has exploded! KS2 – 1. Girls have swapped places. 2. Green guy is flying. 3. Batman and B Guy have swapped places. 4. Girl has disappeared. 5. There are two red guys but no purple guy. 6. B guy is upside down. 7. Yellow caped guy exploded.</p>	<p>Unmute all as children arrive – make visual contact with a parent. Then mute all and go round to hear children speak, unmuting one child at a time. Establish signal eg. hands up / hat on / finger on nose to speak during discussion.</p>
5-15	<p>Recap story: Review whole story of David using stills on powerpoint. Children indicate how things were going for David in that moment of time. KS1: Use thumbs up thumbs down. KS2: Show Awful to Awesome on fingers using numbered scale 0 - 10.</p>	
15-20	<p>Hero Academy Discussion (Captain Awesome's top tips) Discuss David's advice to his son Solomon. KS1: If someone asked you how they could have a good day, what would you say? David wanted to explain to Solomon how to have a good life. What do you think he said? KS2: If someone asked you – how can I live right? What would you say? Look at David's advice to Solomon. Has anyone ever said this to you? What did you think? Look at psalm 23 if time and think about questions on powerpoint slide linking psalm 23 to our lives.</p>	
20-25	<p>Pray: Ask children for prayer requests. Allow individuals to pray – leader to close.</p>	
25-30	<p>News: Ask the children to share their news before saying goodbye</p>
