Unlikely hero: David's heart for the King

Sustained by God

Read [Psalm 62](#)

1. Given that Psalm 62 was written by David as he fled from the rebellion led by his son Absalom – what can we learn from this psalm about trusting God in challenging times? What phrases strike you particularly as faith inspiring?

2. Read v11 & 12. We talked about the fact that as David pours out his heart to God, he comes to the point where he separates the "shadow from the substance". In other words, he recognizes what will endure.

Difficulties *will* pass.

Challenges *can* be overcome in God's strength.

God's power & God's love will endure.

Pray for those in your group who are struggling particularly with the pressures of the current pandemic.
