## 2 Corinthians 1:15-22 - God's Promises

Ray looked at four major promises: Love, Forgiveness, Provision, and Hope. Which of these are you most in need of reminding of?

Scripture references:

**Love** – Psalm 8:38-39; Psalm 103:17; John 15:13

**Forgiveness** – Romans 3:23-24; 1 John 1:19; Acts 13:38

**Provision** – Matt 7:9-11; Matt 6:7-8; Phil 4:19

**Hope** – John 14:2-3; Psalm 25:5; Col 1:27

There are apparently over 7,000 promises in the Bible. Is there a particular promise you need right now? Why not find some references? Bible Gateway is a great way of searching for verses if you don't know where they are.

“Amen” means “yes”, or “I agree”. Can you say “Amen” to the promises God has made to you? What might stop you? Satan will try to make you doubt God and his word. Remember how he put doubt in Eve's mind when he said “Did God really say...” How can you stand firm on the promises of God?

Being secure in these promises makes a difference to the way we live our lives. How do we live in light of them? Do we share those same promises with the people we meet? Matt 10:8 says “Freely you have received. Freely give.” Who do you know who needs to hear these promises, and how can you be practical in your response?
