- 3) What was your favourite Christmas present?
- 4) The story tells us that Jesus listened to the teachers and asked questions. Questions help us to understand things; do you like to ask questions?
- 5) Are you looking forward to going back to school?
- 6) What do you think Jesus means when he says, "didn't you know I had to be in my father's house"?
- 7) Christmas cake or chocolate log? Snow or rain? Hot or cold?
- 8) Jesus knew what it was like to be a child. How does this make you feel?
- 9) What does 'obedient' mean? How does God feel when we are obedient?
- 10) Would you rather be a detective or a pilot? Would you rather jump as far as a Kangaroo or hold your breath as long as a whale?
- 11) The story tells us Jesus grew in wisdom. How can we become wise like Jesus?
- 12) Even at 12 years old Jesus knew that God was his Father. How does it make you feel knowing that you are a child of God?
