



## Questions for Further Study

22<sup>nd</sup> January 2023

Ephesians 2:1-10

1. (v2) All of us were once spiritually dead. Take a few moments to talk about how and why you became a Christian (It's good practice to tell others your testimony. Someone may need to hear it this week!).
2. What elements do the testimonies have in common? Identify the actions of other Christians on your faith journey. What comfort/encouragement can we take from them?
3. (v6-7) CS Lewis wrote: "Christians who did the most for the present world were those who thought the most of the next." Do you have an eternal perspective? What difference does it make to our lives and the lives of those we meet every day?
4. (v10) You are God's masterpiece, or 'poem'. What does that mean to you?
5. Often, we cannot see our good qualities, because we are focussed on the things we do wrong. Give each person a piece of paper and get them to write their name on the top. Pass the sheets around the group. Everyone should write something positive about the person named. When the sheet gets back to the person, they will have lots of encouraging words to think about this next week.
6. You may also like to share communion together.
