Ephesians 3: 1-13

1. In what ways has worshipping and meeting with people from different backgrounds enriched your life? Do you feel that you encounter these people regularly? How can we as a church encourage members to meet up with different kinds of people? (Consider gender, age, race, relationship status, etc)
2. (v8) What are the “boundless riches of Christ” that Paul says he shares with unbelievers?
3. God is in the business of bringing together. Think of those who surround you. Are their divisions, bad feeling or disharmony in any of the relationships? What can you do to improve things? When does our responsibility to promote peace stop? (See Romans 12:18)
4. Have you ever felt as if you needed to earn God’s favour, or work harder/longer so you don’t let God down? Why do we find it so hard to just accept and be?
5. (v8) How has God transformed you? How does this encourage us to pray big prayers for others?
6. (v10) The church is called to reveal God’s wisdom, not just to people, but to the angelic powers. Why?
